Foodshare Fundraiser– Stalls for this Market day are still available so spread the word to anyone you know - for further information contact Derek or Bianca.



What's Ahead

As we are now in the Green Season of the Church for quite a while now we will turn our attention to another area of the Church—Days and Saints

Transfiguration Tuesday 6 August— a Christian feast that commemorates the **transfiguration** of Christ on a mountaintop in the presence of three disciples and that is observed on August 6 in the Roman Catholic and some Eastern churches and on the **Sunday** before Lent in most Protestant churches.

Assumption—Thursday 15 August—The feast day of the **Assumption** of Mary **celebrates** the Christian belief that God assumed the Virgin Mary into Heaven following her death. It is **celebrated** on or around August 15 in many countries, particularly in parts of Europe and South America

Saturday 10 August—St Laurance—or Laurence (Latin: Laurentius, lit. "laurelled";

31 December AD 225 – 10 August 258) was one of the seven deacons of the city of Rome,

Italy, under Pope Sixtus II who were martyred in the persecution of the Christians that the

Roman Emperor Valerian ordered in 258.

Saturday 24 August—St Bartholomew—lived in the first century AD and was one of the Twelve Apostles of Jesus Christ. He was introduced to Christ through **St**. Philip and is also known as "Nathaniel of Cana in Galilee," notably in John's Gospel. **St**. **Bartholomew** is credited with many miracles related to the weight of objects.


What's been happening


