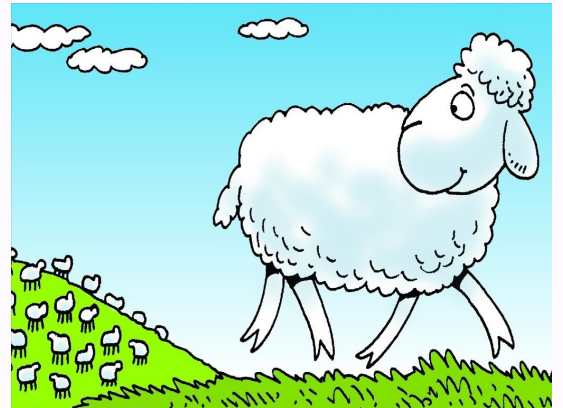
Luke 15.1-10

Just so, I tell you, there is joy in the presence of the angels of God over one sinner who repents.'

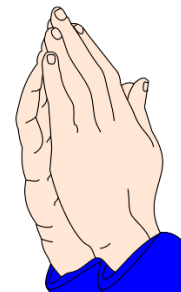
